 •When taking fruits, vegetables and other such plants and items from Japan into another country, you must comply with the phytosanitary regulations of the importing country.  
 •Requirements for each items in this table are based on the legislation and regulations of importing countries.  
 •For information on items or destination countries which are not included in this table, please contact to Japanese Plant Protection Station.

**[About the marks on the table]**  
 ⊙: Exportable without either a phytosanitary certificate or import permit.  
 Q: A phytosanitary certificate (note 1) is required.  
 P: An import permit (note 2) is required.  
 ☆: Only items which meet special conditions based on bilateral agreements can be exported.  
 X: Cannot export.

(note 1: A phytosanitary certificates will be issued if items pass phytosanitary export inspections in Japan.)  
 (note 2: An import permit is issued by notional plant protection authority of the importing country.)

**[Notes]**  
 \*1 Generally prohibited by the importing country.  
 \*2 Phytosanitary import requirements have not been established by the importing country or are indefinite.  
 \*3 Items produced in south of northern latitude of 30 degrees in the Nansei Islands, Ogasawara Islands, and Daito Islands are prohibited by the importing country.  
 \*4 For Cyprus Only: fruits must have no leaves. Phytosanitary certificate and either growing site inspections or phytosanitary treatment for Phyloxera are required.  
 \*5 Importing during the period 17 April to 30 September, a phytosanitary certificate will be required.  
 \*6 Items produced in the Amami Islands, Ogasawara Islands, Ryukyu Islands, Tokara Islands, and Volcano Islands are prohibited by importing countries.  
 \*7 For France (Brittany region), Ireland, Portugal (Azores), Finland, and United Kingdom (Northern Ireland) Only: A phytosanitary certificate is required.  
 \*8 Growing site inspection and Phytosanitary treatment are required.  
 \*9 Growing site inspection is required.  
 \*10 Phytosanitary treatment is required.  
 \*11 Suspended by the importing country.  
 \*12 Items may not be required import permit nor phytosanitary certificate.  
 \*13 There is a weight limit.  
 \*14 Must be packed in clean new bags.  
 \*15 Prohibited for personal use by the importing country.  
 \*16 For personal use, growing site inspection and phytosanitary certificate are required.  
 \*17 Items produced in Nansei Islands, Ogasawara Islands, and Daito Islands are prohibited by the importing country.  
 \*18 Depending on the district of production, the importing country prohibits. Please contact us for more details.

※ Precautions  
 1. Precautions in usage  
 Although we aim to provide accurate quarantine condition information here, in some cases, it may differ slightly from the actual conditions, because importing countries may change their regulations at any time. We recommend that you confirm the latest import conditions of importing countries through concerned parties such as local importers, or contact to the embassy of importing country in Japan before exporting.  
 Conditions in this table are merely the plant quarantine requirements of each country, and in some cases there may be import restrictions based on other regulations of the country or CITES, even if those items can be exported according to this table.  
 2. Import permit systems in importing countries  
 For contact and procedures regarding an import permit of an importing country, inquire of the national plant protection organisation or agricultural authority of the importing country through concerned parties such as local importers, or the embassy of importing country in Japan.
